Council has decided to have a budget workshop on Tuesday, February 15 at 6:00 p.m.

Council will using the same company for well inspections as 2021.

Council instructed the Clerk to move forward with ordering the baffle for the lagoon.

Council picked a couple dates in March to continue reviewing our City Code book.

Council set Tuesday, March 8, 2022, for the public meeting and approving the FY2023 City Budget.

Poage moved to adjourn the meeting, Lloyd seconded. Vote: AIF. Meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
