A motion by Quandt to approve a \$5,000 matching grant to Garner Community Christian Child Care for their First Children's Finance Strategic Plan development project was supported by Bell. Motion carried 5-0.

A motion by Jenniges to approve Resolution 2022-35, a resolution to provide notice of hearing and letting for the Reserve 2 residential development project was supported by Bell. Roll call vote: Ayes: Quandt, Bell, Jenniges, Lewerke, and Juhl. Nays: None. Motion carried.

A motion by Juhl to set a public hearing for May 24, 2022 for the FY-22 budget amendment was supported by Quandt. Motion carried 5-0

Council directed City staff to prepare a resolution adding one week of vacation for the first year of employment for City employees.

It was noted that the HCEDC Executive Breakfast is this Thursday at 7:30 am and that the GHV Jazz band will be playing in Central Park at 11:30 am on May 23.

Mayor Schmidt proclaimed May as Motorcycle Awareness Month.

During open discussion, Lewerke asked about food truck permits. City Clerk White shared that food trucks need to have a peddlers permit.

Collins noted annual employee reviews are starting and would be conducted by Supervisors of Direct Reports only.
