RESOLUTION NO. 2022-026

NOXIOUS WEED NOTICE TO ALL LANDOWNERS, OC-CUPANTS AND PERSONS IN POSSESSION OR CONTROL IN-CLUDING RAILROADS, LANDS, AND LOTS WI' COUNTY, IOWA: WITHIN HANCOCK

The Board of Supervisors of Han-

cock County, lowa, in a meeting held on May 2, 2022 passed the following Resolution, to wit:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Hancock County,

lowa, that pursuant to the provision of Chapter 317, Code of lowa, it is hereby ordered:

1. That each owner and each person in possession or control of any land or lots in Hancock County,

lowa, shall cut, burn or otherwise destroy all noxious weeds thereon, as defined in this Chapter, at such times, in each year, in such manner as shall prevent said weeds from blooming or coming to maturity, and shall keep said lands free from such growth of any other weeds, as shall render the streets and highways

the following dates and as often thereafter as is necessary to pre-GROUP 1: June 15, 2022 for leafy spurge, perennial pepper-grass, sour dock, smooth dock, sheep sorrel, and common and

adjoining said land unsafe for public

travel. Noxious weeds shall be cut or otherwise destroyed on or before

glossy buckthorn. GROUP 2: June 15, 2022 for Canadian thistle, bull thistle, other thistle belonging in genera or cirsium, Russian knapweed, quack grass, wild mustard, shatter cane, teasel

and palmer amaranth.

GROUP 3: July 15, 2022 for field bindweed and wild carrot.

GROUP 4: July 15, 2022 for sunflower, horse nettle, perennial

sow thistle, cocklebur, butter print (velvet leaf), puncture vine, poison hemlock, multi-flora rose and mar

ijiuana.

2. That each person and owner in possession or control of any land in Hancock County, infested with any

noxious weed, as listed above, shall adopt a program of weed destruction prescribed by the Weed Com-mission which in five years may be expected to destroy and will imme-diately keep under control such in-

diately keep under control such in-festations of said noxious weeds.

3. That all weeds other than noxious weeds on all county truck primary and local county roads and between the fence lines thereof, shall be treated by the adjoining property owners to prevent seed production on or before JULY 15,

production on or before JULY 13, 2022.

4. That if the owner or person in possession or control of any land in Hancock County, lowa, fail to comply with the foregoing orders, the Weed Commission shall cause this to be done and the expense of said work including costs of serving

notice and other costs, if any, to be assessed against the land and the owners thereof. 5. That the County Auditor be and
