RESOLUTION FOR PARTICIPATION IN SS4A GRANT APPLICATION
Hancock County Resolution No. 2022-042
WHEREAS, as part of the new Federal Transportation Bill, Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), there is over \$1B of roadway

safety funding available in the form of Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grants. To be an eligible applicant for this new safety funding, a county MUST have an eligible Action Plan in place; and
WHEREAS, the Iowa County Engineers Association (ICEA) plans to apply for a SS4A grant to develop and supply all 99 counties in Iowa with an eligible Action Plan at no cost to the counties. ICEA encourages all 99 counties to participate in this grant application; and
WHEREAS, the Hancock County Board of Supervisors will commit to achieve significant declines in roadway fatalities and serious injuries in Hancock County; and
WHEREAS, the Hancock County Board of Supervisors recognizes the Action Plan and will assist the County Engineer's department in achieving the goal of a dramatic decrease in roadway fatalities and serious injuries and zero roadway fatalities and serious injuries by the years 2030 and 2050, respectively; and
WHEREAS, the Hancock County Board of Supervisors, after consulting with the Hancock County Engineer, desires to participate in a joint SS4A grant to develop and receive an eligible Action Plan for Hancock County.
THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HANCOCK COUNTY

that this County does hereby request to be included in the statewide SS4A grant to develop Actions Plans for all 99 counties in Iowa.
Motion made by Supervisor Rayhons to enter into closed session pursuant to Iowa Code section 21.5 (1)(j), to discuss the purchase or sale of particular real estate only where premature disclosure could be reasonably expected to increase the price the governmental body would have to pay for that property or reduce the price the governmental body would receive for that property. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Greiman and the vote was unanimous to hold a closed session pursuant to Iowa Code section 21.5 (1)(j). Supervisors present were Greiman, Rayhons, and Tlach. The Board of Supervisors entered into closed session. Minutes were taken and a tape recording made. The recording and minutes were sealed and secured in an envelope, and no person will be permitted to examine them without a court order.
