• Public hearing on the status of the City of Corwith CDBG rehab program and Release of CDBG rehab program forgivable loan was tabled until the June 14, 2022, meeting due to weather.

• Lloyd moved to approve Resolution 1228 - appointing part time public works employee, Tindall seconded. Vote: AIF. Poage absent.

• Lloyd moved to approve the resignation of Corwith City Clerk, Tindall seconded. Vote: AIF.

• Lloyd and Tindall volunteered to be on the hiring committee for both the public works director and city clerk open position.

• Lloyd moved to approve resolution 1229 - Corwith Community Club liquor license, Tindall seconded. Vote: AIF. Poage absent.

• Steenhard moved to approve Resolution 1230- Appointment of Michelle Garman to fill the vacancy for the at large city council position for the City of Corwith, Lloyd seconded. Vote: AIF. Poage absent.

• The first reading of Ordinance 224 - amending the Corwith Municipal code to increase the utility deposit.

Council meeting was abruptly adjourned due to the severe weather that was in the area and the sirens going off at 7:04 p.m. Remaining agenda items will be added to the May agenda if no special meeting is called before May 10, 2022.
