The Council tells Matt to look into it more with insurance and liability of the city. Insurance recommends having an Ordinance because if there is an incident, the City could be liable. Consensus is to simplify the process and fine tune the ordinance. There are trees at Pool Park

that may need to be removed. -West side of Pool Park. One dead, one almost dead. West of Tennis Courts.

· A group of people that are helping with Duesey Days met last week and will meet again Thursday June 10th, 2021.
