PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE CITY OF GARNER, IOWA

The City of Garner will be holding two sequential public hearings at 7:00 p.m. on August 24th, 2021, at the GARNER CITY HALL, 135 W 5th St., Garner. The first hearing will focus on obtaining input into a Community Development and Housing Needs Assessment (CDHNA). Input from the public is requested in identifying needs and projects to improve the city. The second hearing will focus on input regarding the submission of a CDBG-CV Housing Conversion Grant application to the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA) for the development of residential apartments in an upper story of a downtown building located at 314 State St., Garner. You are welcome to provide comments to City Administrator Adam Kofoed at City Hall, 135 W 5th St., Garner, IA 50438 or 641-923-2588. The grant application is expected to be submitted for consideration by September 1, 2021.

No persons or businesses will be permanently displaced as a result of the project. The Mayor and City Council urge all interested parties to attend. Everyone will be invited to provide input. A representative from the North Iowa Area Council of Governments (NIACOG) will be available to respond to questions regarding the CDHNA and grant application.
