HANCOCK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS December 13, 2021 Garner, Iowa

The Hancock County, lowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of December 6, 2021 meeting were read and approved.

A public hearing was held for the

county to enter into a General Obligation County Purpose Loan Agreement. Those present for the hearing were Supervisors Greiman, Rayhons, and Tlach, Absent: none; Auditor Michelle K. Eisenman, Sheriff Rob Gerdes, Communications/ EMA/E911/Zoning Director Andy Buffington and County Engineer Jeremy Purvis. Present from the public were Angela Nelson-KIOW, Glen Alden, Gary Schleusner, and Shari Schmitz-Motorola. Present via Go to Meeting was Rob Hillesland-Gazette/Summit-Tribune, Globe Rebecca Peter-Leader, and Donald Johnson. There were no oral or written objections received. Only public comment received was a question on the number of years of the loan agreement and the interest rate. On motion by Supervisor Greiman to close the public hearing, seconded

by Supervisor Tlach. All ayes.
On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-055 Resolution Taking Additional Action on Proposal to Enter into a General Obligation County Purpose Loan Agreement

WHEREAS, the Board of Su-pervisors (the "Board") of Hancock County, Iowa (the "County") heretofore proposed to authorize the County to enter into a loan agreement (the "Loan Agreement") and to borrow money thereunder in a principal amount not to exceed \$2,325,000, pursuant to the provisions of Section 331.402 of the Code of Iowa, for the purpose of paying the costs, to that extent, of (1) acquiring and installing emergency communications equipment and systems; (2) undertaking the Northwest Tower Repair Project at the County Courthouse; and (3) undertaking the East Entrance Vestibule Project at the County Courthouse, and pursuant to law and duly published notice of the proposed action, has held a hearing

thereon on December 13, 2021; NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Hancock County, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby determines to enter into the Loan Agreement in the future and orders that General Obligation County Purpose Bonds (the "Bonds") be issued at such time, in evidence thereof. The Board of Supervisors further declares that this resolution constitutes the "additional action" required by Section 384.24A of the Code of Iowa.

Section 2. Further action with respect to the Loan Agreement and the Bonds is hereby adjourned to the meeting of the Board on January 3, 2022.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval, as provided by law.

Resolution Adopting and Approving Tax Compliance Procedures Relating to Tax-Exempt Bonds

WHEREAS, the County deems it necessary and desirable to adopt certain procedures and practices to be followed by the County in connection with the issuance of Tax Exempt Bonds; and

WHEREAS, proposed tax compliance procedures are attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Compliance Procedures"):

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Hancock County, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The Compliance Procedures attached hereto as Exhibit A are hereby adopted and shall be dated as of the date hereof.

Section 2. The County Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to periodically update the Compliance Procedures in accordance with the Internal Revenue Code and supporting Internal Revenue Service Rulings and Regulations, with advice from bond counsel.
