HANCOCK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

December 28, 2021

Garner, Iowa

The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of December 20, 2021 meeting were read and approved.

A public hearing was held on Hancock County precinct boundaries and Ordinance no. 17, an ordinance to re-establish election precinct boundaries in Hancock County. Those present for the hearing were Supervisors Greiman, Rayhons, and Tlach, Absent: none; Auditor Michelle Eisenman. Present via Go to Meeting was Rob Hillesland-Globe Gazette. Certification that publication as to the date and time and place of the hearing was on file in the Auditor's Office. Auditor Eisenman reviewed the precincts and populations noting there were no changes to the precincts except certification of populations. There were no other comments received. On motion by Supervisor Greiman to close the public hearing, seconded by Supervisor Tlach. All ayes.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Tlach and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: First and final reading, waived the second and third readings, of Hancock County Ordinance no. 17, an ordinance to re-establish election precinct boundaries in Hancock County with publication of said ordinance in official newspapers to follow. Mutual Precinct Boundary Agreement between City of Garner and Hancock County State of Iowa. Mutual Precinct Boundary Agreement between City of Forest City and Hancock County State of Iowa.

On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: County reprecincting worksheet. Mutual Precinct Boundary Agreement between City of Britt and Hancock County State of Iowa.

No further business to come before the Board, motion made to adjourn at 10:01 a.m. by Supervisor Tlach and carried. All Supervisors present voting, "Aye," session to adjourn and will meet again on January 3, 2022.
