HANCOCK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of May 16, 2022 meeting were read and approved. On motion by Supervisor Rayhons, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Signed 28E agreement for General

Assistance Administration between Hancock County and Hancock County Health System. Five-day class B beer permit for Backpocket Brewing, LLC doing business as Backpocket Brewing with outdoor service beginning July 27, 2022. Certification of drainage district levies for collection with Fall taxes in 2022.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Rayhons and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Abatement of uncollectible taxes for Alex or Samantha Pettit for mobile home parcel number 61216 in the amount of \$223.00.
