You are further notified that unless prior to said Hearing you serve, and within a reasonable time thereafter file, a written Appearance, Motion, or Answer in the Iowa District Court for Hancock County, at the County Courthouse in Garner, Iowa, judgment by default may be rendered against you for the relief demanded in the Petition.

You have the right to court appointed counsel pursuant to Iowa Code §600A.6A if you are indigent.
