City Council Proceedings from March 26, 2021

The Kanawha City Council met in special open session, Friday, March 26, 2021, in the City Council chambers.

Council members present were Lemay, Baker, Bassett and Vander Ploeg. Council member Purvis was absent. Mayor Sobek called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Four applications for the Supt. of Public Works position were received and reviewed. All four candidates were interviewed during the meeting and then discussion was held on offering the job to the applicant we felt would be the best. Mayor Sobek will contact city attorney about the possibility of a contract with the new Supt. of Public Works candidate.

Councilperson Bassett moved to offer the job to Jessie Salinas pending approval of a contract. The motion was seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Councilperson Bassett moved to set starting pay at \$21.50/hr. with a raise after Salinas obtains his CDL and water testing licenses. The motion was seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Councilperson Bassett moved approval of contract with North Iowa Environmental for water plant services. Motion was seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Councilperson Lemay moved approval of a wage increase for Cole Schisel to \$15.00 per hour. Motion was seconded. Lemay, Baker and Bassett were in favor. Vander Ploeg was not in favor. Motion carried.

Councilperson Lemay moved for adjournment at 7:45 p.m. The motion was seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.
