

OFFICIAL COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS: City of Klemme

Klemme City Council Proceedings Monday January 3, 2022

The Klemme City Council met at the regular meeting on Monday January 3, at 6:30 PM, Council Chambers, City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Blank. Present: Abele, Jergenson, Menke, Taft and Boge-Miller

Taft made a motion to accept the agenda. Boge-Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Menke made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Boge-Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Taft made a motion, with a second from Menke, to approve the payment of the bills as presented. Motion carried.

The Sheriff's Report was reviewed.

Kathy Olthoff, Library Director, presented the FY 2022/2023 Library Budget to the council. Olthoff reviewed the budget and answered questions concerning the library budget. The proposed budget is for a total spending of \$ 58,505.72 which is \$ 980.56 more than last year. Boge-Miller made a motion, with a second from Taft, to approve the Library Budget as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Blank made some changes to the council member's appointments due to the election of new members:

Mayor Pro Tem – Boge-Miller, Landfill Board Representative-Abele, Insurance & Administration – Abele and Jergenson, Library & Parks – Taft and Boge-Miller, Emergency & Police Protection – Boge-Miller and Jergenson, Water & Sanitation – Menke and Taft, Streets & Sewers – Abele and Menke.

Boge-Miller made a motion, with

a second from Menke, to appoint Colleen Rout as City Clerk. Motion carried.

Taft made a motion to appoint Gary Berkland as City Attorney. Menke seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Boge-Miller made a motion that the Garner Leader be the designated official newspaper for the City of Klemme. Jergenson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Menke made a motion, with a second from Boge-Miller, to designate Reliance State Bank as the official depository, with the maximum deposit amount set at \$750,000. Motion carried.

Boge-Miller made a motion, with a second from Taft, to re-appoint Kenneth Weiland to the Zoning Board for a 5 year term. Motion carried.

Boge-Miller made a motion, with a second from Menke, to appoint Morris Crotty to fill a vacancy on the Board Of Adjustments for a 5 year term and re-appoint Duane Pringnitz for a 5 year term. Motion carried.

Taft made a motion to set February 7, 2022 at 6:30 pm at the City Hall to be the date, time, and place for the public max levy hearing. Menke seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Abele made a motion, with a second from Boge-Miller to approve resolution #01-03-22 mileage reimbursement for City employees. Motion carried.

Menke made a motion, to have the City's landfill representative-Abele to look into purchasing the landfills old end loader blade to replace City's current one. Taft seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kenneth Weiland, Public Works Director, was present at the meeting. Weiland informed the council that he had been in contact with the

DNR about the purchase of a new City truck. They have put the City's name on the list for availability. Two more water shut off's had been located.

City Clerk, Colleen Rout, reviewed with the council the Budget for 2022/2023. The council discussed whether to leave the same or to raise the amounts for future items to consider in 2022/2023. She will incorporate the amounts decided on and type up a new draft for the council to review. She also asked the council to let her know at the February meeting if there are any changes or additions that the city might need to add before the final hearing in March.

Boge-Miller made a motion, with a second from Menke, to adjourn. Meeting adjourned. Colleen Rout, City Clerk/Treasurer
