

PROCEEDINGS: Klemme

Klemme City Council Proceedings Monday March 7, 2022

The Klemme City Council met at the regular meeting on Monday February 7, at 6:30 PM, Council Chambers, City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Blank. Present: Abele, Jergenson, and Boge-Miller. Absent Taft and Menke.

Boge-Miller made a motion to accept the agenda. Abele seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Abele made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Boge-Miller seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jergenson made a motion, with a second from Abele, to approve the payment of the bills as presented. Motion carried.

The Sheriff's Report was reviewed.

The Mayor opened the public hearing for 2022/2023 Budget. There were no public opinions on the city's FY 2022/2023 proposed budget. The Mayor then closed the public hearing.

Abele made a motion to approve Resolution #03-07-22, acceptance of the fiscal year 2022-2023 budget and instructed the City Clerk to file the necessary paperwork as required by law. Boge-Miller seconded the motion. Roll call was made with those voting Aye: Abele, Jergenson, and Boge-Miller. Those voting Nay: None. Motion carried.

Tom Christianson with Jaspersen Insurance presented the council will a few options for the renewal of the City's insurance.

Jon Hanson and Tere Becker with Raked Ape Cycle were present to ask about closing off part of the main street for a bike show, how to get approval of a liquor license for the day, along with who to contact about a building permit.

Boge-Miller made a motion to set the dates for the burning of yard waste from April 1, 2022 to May 31, 2022, unless a burn ban goes into place. Jergenson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Kenneth Weiland, Public Works Director, was present at the meeting. Weiland informed the council that the new aerator had been installed at the lagoon. Visa-Sewer will be back this spring to check out sewer lines. Heartland will be check streets for blacktopping.

Comments from the audience where about junk vehicles and properties in town. Councilmembers present suggested these topics be put on the April agenda when there will be a full council on hand to discuss the issue.

Abele made a motion, with a second from Boge-Miller, to adjourn. Meeting adjourned.
