## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF STORM WATER DISCHARGE**

Gold Eagle Coop plans to submit a Notice of Intent to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to be covered under the NPDES General Permit Number 2 "Storm Water Discharge Associated with Industrial Activity for Construction Activities" for public construction in Hancock County, Iowa.

The stormwater discharge will be from site grading associated with the erection of NH<sub>3</sub> storage tanks, NH<sub>3</sub> riser platform, gravel surfacing, associated grading, and final seeding in Hancock County, IA. Soil disturbing activities will include the following: site clearing and grading, perimeter and other erosion and sediment controls, excavation, and roadway construction. The project is located within Bingham Township, Hancock County, Iowa along the northwest city limits of Woden, IA and more specifically within Section 10, T-97-N, R-26-W Hancock County, Iowa.

Runoff currently sheet flows off site to the south. The proposed site will sheet flow off-site through two non-point sources, with around half of the site to each the east and west. Through ditches, the runoff will flow 4,000' south to Lindsey Creek and 17 miles southwest to East Fork Des Moines River.
